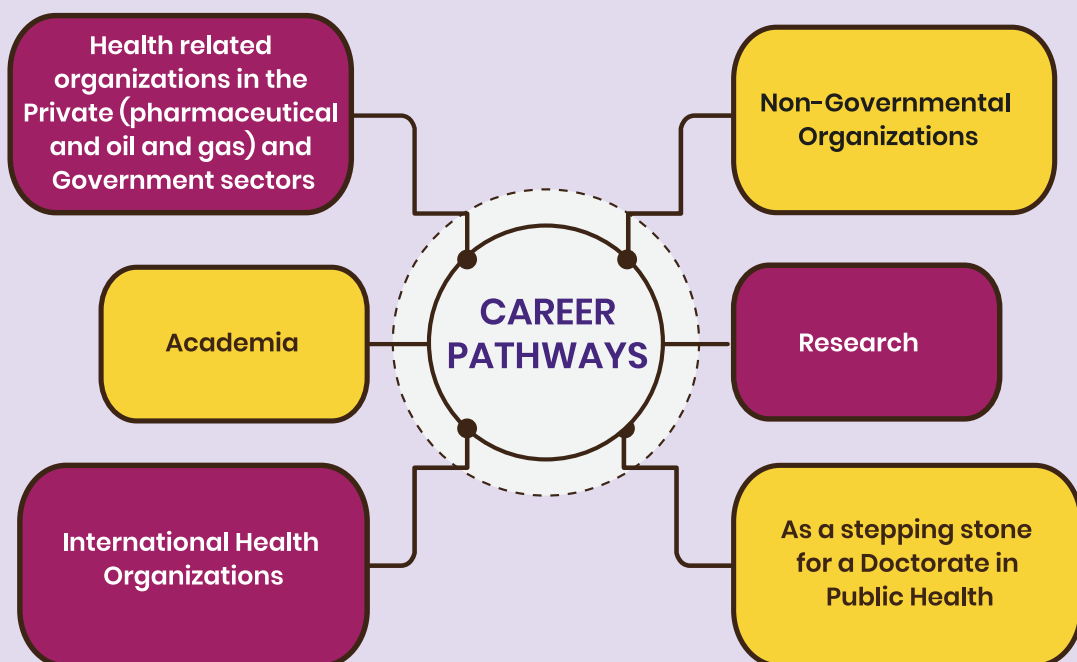


WHO WILL MENTOR ME?

HOW AM I ASSESSED?

ACADEMIC CRITERIA

A health-related Bachelor's degree with a minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 2.50/4.00, as accepted by the Perdana University Senate

A health-related Bachelor's degree not meeting a CGPA of 2.50/4.00 can be accepted subject to a minimum of five years working experience in a relevant field.
